# Correspondence from RADM Ellis to ATSD (AE)

- Requested assistance in obtaining DoD support to replace B53
- Cited absence of modern safety design criteria
- Recommended procedural safeguards until P53 retired
- Recommended retirement of B53 at earliest possible date.

AL and Laboratory Requirements

- Priorities
  - Military Characteristics and Stockpile to Target Sequence
  - Classification Guidelines
- If baseline design will not satisfy requirements, then advise Headquarters and get guidance before pursuing other design options

# Classification Guidelines

Classification guidelines pending promulgation of formal classification guidance

- Protect unique operational capabilities as SFRD until decision by original classification authority
- Use W61 classification guidance and CG-W-5 for other points
