THIS MESSAGE ANNOUNCES THE CONSOLIDATION OF JOINT PUBLICATION (JP) 3-12, "DOCTRINE FOR JOINT NUCLEAR OPERATIONS", AND JP 3-12.1, "DOCTRINE FOR JOINT THEATER NUCLEAR OPERATIONS", INTO A SINGLE JOINT PUBLICATION 3-12, "DOCTRINE FOR JOINT NUCLEAR OPERATIONS." US STRATEGIC COMMAND (USSTRATCOM) IS ASSIGNED AS THE LEAD AGENT FOR THE REVISED JP 3-12, WITH THE JOINT STAFF J5 AS THE JOINT STAFF DOCTRINE SPONSOR (JSDS).

2. BACKGROUND. US JOINT FORCES COMMAND (USJFCOM) JOINT WARFIGHTING CENTER (JWFC) ASSESSED THE UTILITY AND QUALITY OF THE CURRENT JP 3-12 AND JP 3-12.1. THEIR FINDINGS REFLECT THE RESULTS OF AN ANALYSIS BASED ON DATA COLLECTED FROM NUMEROUS SOURCES, TO INCLUDE INPUT FROM
